

Homeward Bound is holding an Emergency Donation Drive and will be collecting items at our donation center at 205 Elk Park Drive in Woodfin. Items critically needed at this time include: Camping gear, toilet paper, paper towels, trash bags, disinfectant cleaning supplies including wipes, regular baby wipes, disposable gloves, towels, soap, underwear, socks, and unopened (without the seal broken) over-the-counter medications such as relievers and cold medicine. Donors may drop items off any time of day, but preference is between 11:00am and 2:00pm outside the front door and placed in the donation bins. In an effort to promote social distancing and to curb any potential spread of illness, donation center doors will not be open to the public and donated items will be sanitized upon receipt.



Homeward Bound will be hosting April 5-11 Room in the Inn (RITI) week with Haywood Street Congregation. We will have the volunteers beds in the acupuncture room (which is very comfortable) and setup the ladies in the sanctuary. There is also a brand new bathroom and easy access to the smoking area right nearby. RITI women will be escorted by Homeward Bound staff over to Haywood Street each night at 6pm and helping get everyone settled. If so, contact Kate Brown to offer help, 828.776.9741.



Pisgah Legal Services (PLS) is looking for congregations or groups who could provide help for families in crisis during this time. Some families were just starting to get on their feet before they were unemployed due to COVID-19. If you can offer help such as gift cards to Ingles, diapers & wipes, or a refurbished laptop from PC for people (\$100-\$150), these items would be extremely helpful. ALSO, if we may bring anything to you to leave on your front doorstep (groceries, Rx pickup, a copy of The Upper Room Daily Devotional, please let Lee know and we will be glad to deliver!

\$ donations from your Cares Act Federal Government checks. Consider if you are able to donate even a small portion of the check you may receive from our government to one of the many needs at Trinity - our JDHowell Mission Fund (specifically for missions & outreach), the Pastor's Discretionary Fund (often given to church members or community folk in need in small amounts for vital services - Rx's, transportation, educational needs; this could also assist members who have lost their jobs due to Covid-19), the Bless the Schools Fund (given to local school children's medical & educational needs in coordination with school social workers), or our current capital campaign to build our Memorial Garden.




