



TLC HIGHLIGHTS FROM OCT. 25 MTG

- Fall Festival is ready to take place Oct. 29!
- Winter Shelter update
 - Winter shelter will likely begin in January, with Trinity being the first church to host this winter shelter. The initiative continues to work to secure funding to continue the shelter through March, hiring staff to run the shelter (peer support staff to stay overnight & operations managers to coordinate with and amongst the churches and volunteers)
 - We will provide up to 10 bed spaces, with priority given to keeping families intact.
 - We will collaborate with at least 2 other churches (Grace Covenant & Grace Episcopal).
 - Each church will host the space for one month, while offering our volunteer support over the entire winter.
- Grant funding also includes some monies to assist with extra utilizing and building usage costs associated with hosting shelter space.

- We are still on board to host WNC Superheroes Safe Parking program, allowing 3 spots for overnight parking, managed and supervised by WNC Superheroes. Guests will not have access to the building and will be required to register with this program and abide by early departure times in coordination with TUMC and Peak Academy School.
- Dec. 6 we will also host the NC Department of Transportation's community forum on the possible Haywood Road resurfacing plans. 4-7PM in our Fellowship Hall. The public is encouraged to come, see the plans and offer feedback.
- HVAC Capital Campaign going well! Update campaign complete! Thanks to all who have contributed to these extra costs to repair HVAC units.


